IMPORTANT PROPERTY NOTICE

Dear Downtown Menasha Neighbor,

This letter is to notify you of **Rally for the Valley**, a free community fundraising event taking place in Downtown Menasha on **Saturday, October 3, 2026, from 2:00–10:00 PM**.

Because your residence, business, workplace or property is located within or adjacent to the event area, please carefully review the following information regarding street closures, parking and property access on the day of the event.

STREET CLOSURE AREA

The street closure will include:

- Main Street between Racine Street and Menasha City Hall, ending just short of Tayco Street
- Mill Street and Marina Place within the event footprint
- Affected surface parking areas within the event footprint

8:00 AM — LIMITED ACCESS BEGINS

Access to the affected streets and parking areas will become limited as event setup begins.

11:00 AM–12:00 AM — FULL CLOSURE

Vehicles will not be permitted to enter, exit or travel through closed streets—Main Street, Mill Street and Marina Place—or affected parking areas.

NEED YOUR CAR?

Downtown residents and employees should use the Broad Street Ramp/One Menasha Ramp and move vehicles before 8:00 AM Saturday.

MOVE ALL VEHICLES BEFORE 8:00 AM

Affected surface parking areas will be used for the event and will not be accessible or drivable during the closure.

ALTERNATIVE PARKING

The Broad Street Ramp/One Menasha Ramp will be reserved for downtown residents and employees from Friday evening through Sunday.

- Residents and employees who expect to use their vehicles during the event should move them to the Broad Street Ramp/One Menasha Ramp before access becomes limited at 8:00 AM Saturday.
- Residents who do not need their vehicle during the event and have access to a garage or underground parking may alternatively store their vehicles in their designated locations for the entire duration of the event.

The ramp will be secured and managed by Rally for the Valley event volunteers.

PROPERTY ACCESS & MOBILITY ASSISTANCE

Pedestrian access to residences and businesses will remain available throughout the event. For individuals with mobility challenges, limited golf-cart transportation will be available between the Broad Street Ramp/One Menasha Ramp and the residential, business and event areas. Please contact Adrienne Palm in advance when possible if you anticipate needing mobility assistance.

COMMON COUNCIL REVIEW

The Rally for the Valley organizers have applied for special permission to temporarily close the affected streets for this event. If you wish to comment on the proposed closures, please attend the City of Menasha Common Council meeting:

Affected residents, business owners, employees and property representatives may also contact their alderperson regarding the proposed closures.
