Recovery takes many forms. For some families, it means repairing a damaged home. For others, it means finding safe housing, getting help with immediate expenses, replacing essential items or accessing resources that can help them move forward.

That's why Rally for the Valley is supporting three local Fox Cities nonprofit organizations, each contributing to tornado recovery in a different way. Together, their work reflects the reality that rebuilding a community requires more than one organization — and more than one kind of support.

You Decide Where Your Support Goes

Rally for the Valley does not collect individual charitable donations into a central fund and decide how to distribute them later. You choose.

When you make a charitable contribution through Rally for the Valley, you'll be able to learn about each participating nonprofit, select the organization whose work you want to support and follow a direct link to that nonprofit's donation page. Your donation is made directly to the organization you select.

LEAVEN

Meeting immediate needs when families need help most.

LEAVEN provides emergency financial assistance and basic-needs support to people throughout the Fox Cities who are facing financial hardship. For households affected by the July 27 tornado, recovery can bring unexpected expenses and immediate needs that don't always fit neatly into traditional disaster assistance. LEAVEN helps individuals and families navigate those moments by providing direct assistance and connecting people with additional community resources.

Your support can help: Provide emergency financial and basic-needs assistance to local households, including those facing tornado-related expenses and recovery needs.

Opportunities include interviews, photographs, video and other forms of documentation, with options to participate privately or anonymously.
